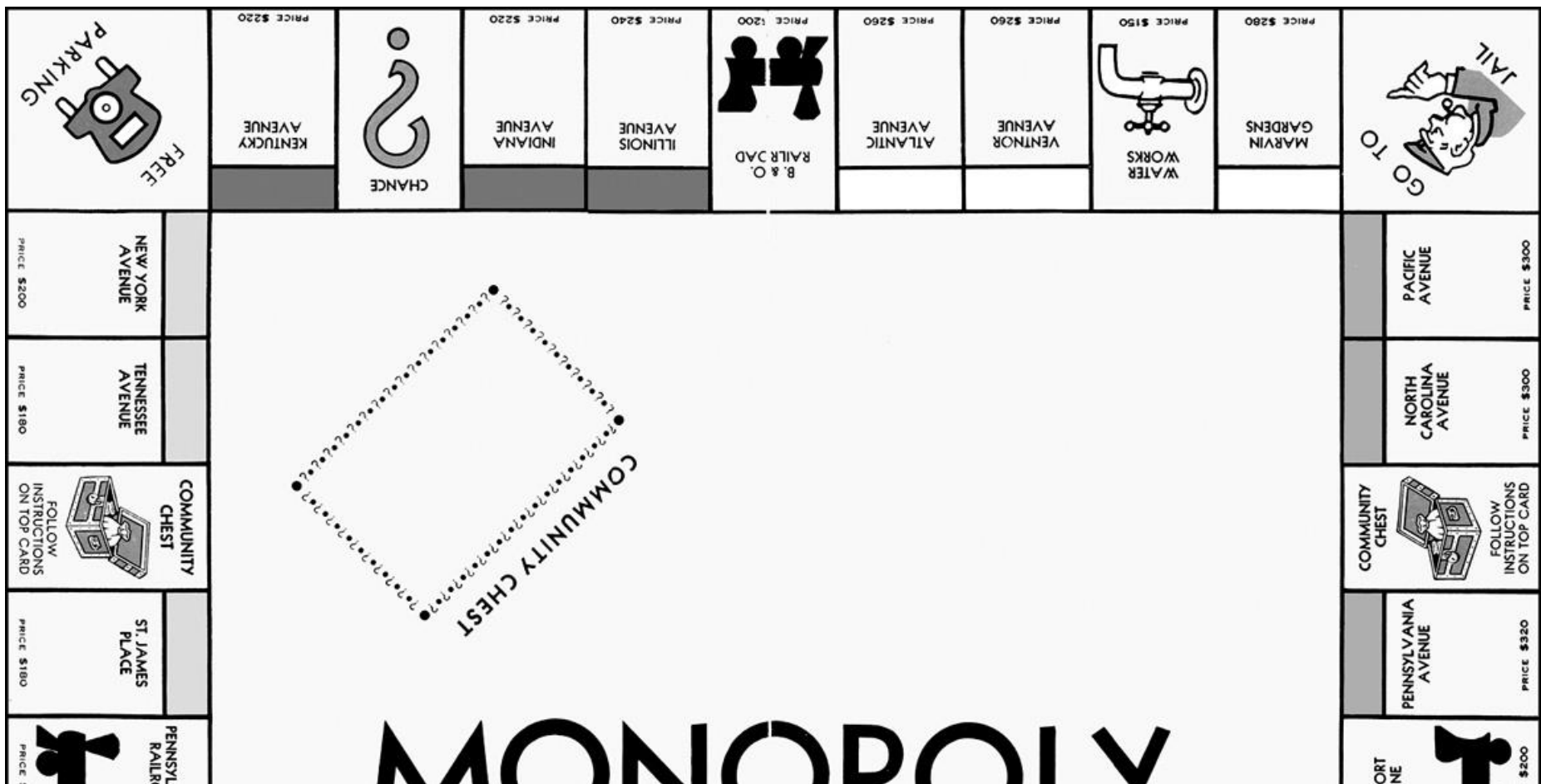


Rationale:

I teach in a CMI school of middle banding. The students usually come from a lower to middle social-economic background. Many parents are new immigrants from China without much English nor the ability to provide an English speaking environment for the students. Students are particularly weak in English, some at primary level. They are fun-loving and some have already taken up part-time jobs. Some many not continue studying when they graduate.

Objective:




This activity is designed to incorporate workplace English into a Monopoly game. The objective is to guide students through the basic procedures of job-hunting, in groups and using very basic core vocabulary they will need for very general jobs. It can be extended to more in-depth and genre-specific texts. It is hoped that their interest can be aroused and their prior knowledge of this game can be applied.



This is the original, traditional Monopoly game board, showing property to purchase and their respective prices. On the way, there are also pitfalls and opportunities.

The content will be changed to jobs (accessible to students) and their respective salary. The dangers and opportunities will be changed to accidents, training and promotion.

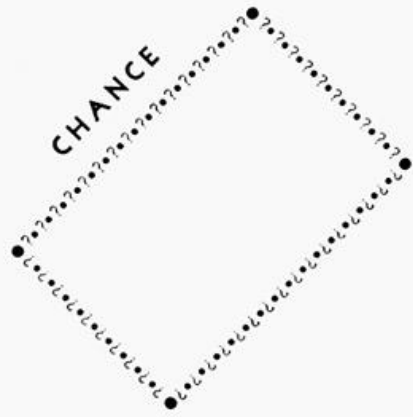

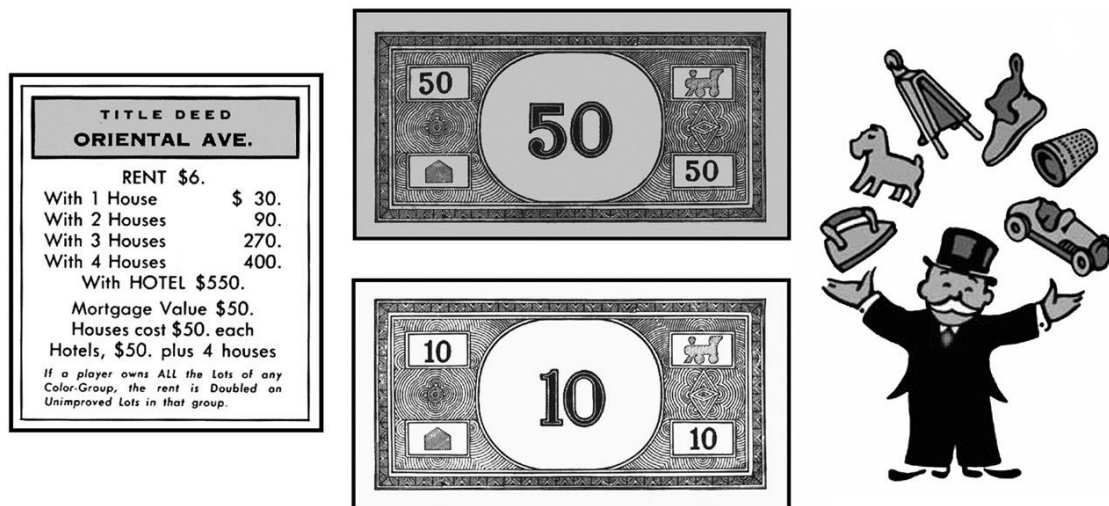
